## In addition: the use of firearms

26/04/2021: LEWP meeting - key figures about the use of firearms were reminded by the chairman of the European Firearms Expert group (EFE) :

- Between 2009 and 2018:
    - 23 mass-shootings occurred in the EU
    - 341 people were killed
  - In 2015: firearms were used in 57 terrorist incidents
  - In 2017: firearms were used in 41% of all terrorist attacks (38 % in 2016)

## b) Prüm regulation, an opportunity for ballistic data exchange ?

Prüm: a legal framework for automated data exchange that can be possibly adapted to the different types of data

### Possible legal options as regards ballistics :

1. Introducing complete legal provisions within the regulation whose implementation date can be delayed in relation with the technical possibilities.
2. Introducing a legal mechanism that could be similar to the one defined in the article 43 of the 2018/1862 regulation (SIS police). Delegated acts as soon as a technical solution is achieved.
