The representatives of Stellantis, IVECO and Ferrari presented their views on the revision of the CO<sub>2</sub> emission standards for light duty vehicles. They underlined the importance of the package approach and the interdependencies in the Fit for 55 proposal - in particular the link between ambition of the CO<sub>2</sub> standards and the availability of recharging infrastructure. They stressed the importance of keeping all technology options open and of acknowledging the different profiles of mass market, small volume manufacturers, and the different approach needed for cars and vans. IVECO also highlighted their preference of considering crediting of renewable fuels for compliance with the CO<sub>2</sub> emission standards.
