Subject: Meeting between Mauro Petriccione, Director General, and representatives of Bosch, Mahle and ZF

The representatives of Bosch, Mahle and ZF presented their views on the preparation of the revision of the CO₂ emission standards for light duty vehicles. They stressed the investment challenges being faced and the time needed for the transition to zero-emission mobility in order to avoid disruptive changes in the automotive suppliers industry and preserve employment. They underlined the importance of the PHEV technology, which will be significantly improved and for which better charging behaviour from consumers should be stimulated. They also proposed options for the crediting of renewable fuels for compliance with the CO₂ emission standards. They pointed to the importance of hydrogen as an important technology for the road transport sector. DG CLIMA provided an overview on the preparatory steps of the 'fit for 55%' package and invited industry representatives to provide additional information on the issues at stake.
