In view of the forthcoming adoption by the European Commission of the Smart Mobility Strategy, the following three associations – EBA, European Biogas Association; GD4S, Gas Distributors for Sustainability and NGVA, Natural Gas Vehicles Association, have prepared the enclosed joint declaration on the importance of gas mobility for achieving carbon footprint reduction targets in the transport sector.

In particular, the three associations are convinced that the contribution of renewable and decarbonised gases to the reduction of CO₂ emissions must be adequately considered and reflected, within the SMS and the EU Taxonomy on Sustainable Finance, in the methodologies used to define the environmental impact of the different types of energy carriers.
