[REDACTED] let me underline that we believe that this meeting between your relevant team members, ours, and a number of our national member federations and EU sectoral employers, is important and timely.

We deplore the fragmented and far-reaching national transposition rules that came under the 2014 enforcement directive on posting of workers. The Commission should play its role as guardian of the EU Treaty to address responsibly the situations where the national posting rules undermine the single market.

In this context, DG GROW's activities to improve posting notifications to make the process less burdensome for companies is important. You should also know that we had a few weeks ago a meeting with Jordi Curell and [REDACTED] in DG EMPL, together with ETUC, and that I informed them during this meeting about our cooperation with DG GROW.
