Issues raised & follow-up	<p><i>Investments into carbon farming</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EVP Timmermans opened the meeting, outlining the Commission approach to carbon farming, along the lines of the carbon farming video (https://twitter.com/TimmermansEU/status/1471182968051970057?s=20&t=KsBQTH5bBU6BJXEs0FiXhw). • On the [REDACTED] side, there was a great consensus on the benefits of carbon farming but also a strong call for a common verification and certification system at EU level, with clarity on permanence and additionality. • Some [REDACTED] raised the issue of data availability. Many of them also called for a broader approach going beyond carbon, and properly reflecting the biodiversity dimension. • EVP Timmermans appreciated the discussion and informed about the timeline for the Communication on sustainable carbon cycles.
