I hope my message finds you well!

We are looking forward to our meeting with Mr Joergensen on 18 May.

In advance of the Paris Saclay meeting, we would also like to share with you ITI's recommendations for the TTC.

Among others, our paper identifies cooperation on R&D for 6G technology, as well as collaboration for building more secure and resilient supply chains for semiconductors and the broader ICT industry, as key priority outcomes.

More broadly, we emphasise six policy outcomes below:

- Accelerate research and development for 6G.
- Commit to relying on internationally recognized, industry-driven, voluntary technical standards.
- Support more resilient and secure supply chains for semiconductors and the broader information and communications technology (ICT) industry.
- Collaborate on AI standards and AI governance.
- Enforce multilateral commitments that benefit U.S. and EU workers and companies.
- Coordinate engagement to address third-market policies of concern, such as increased data flow restrictions in privacy and data governance proposals.
