After our chat and following our discussion, please find attached our contribution to the survey and a document which can better explain our answers. In the meantime, we also filled the target survey proposed by the consultant. With both the questionnaires we faced some issues mainly due to the complexity of the issue which can hardly be explained by simplified answers.

In any case, as we underlined in our document, we want to clarify a couple of principles which we believe can be helpful to better understand our position.

- On the debate on FOPNL, we believe that, due to the importance and the complexity of the debate, policy options should explore many different aspects. The outcomes of the Parliamentary debates showed that to achieve more balanced diets, policy options should also consider other aspects than the content of cherry picked nutrients calculated per 100g/100 ml. The degree of processing and nutrient density on one side, as well as the need to avoid oversimplified judgments by consumers.
- On origin labelling, in both questionnaires, due to many oversimplified questions, we found a little bit difficult to provide meaningful information. Just to give an example, in front of a specific policy option, input prices could have a significant variation because of inflation, consequences of animal diseases, volatile transport costs, prices of commodities, etc. The variation of prices of raw material could have been different if a certain

provision would have been introduced in 2017 or in 2019. In 2017 prices of pigmeat were lower than in 2019 and, as an example, a mandatory indication of the origin of raw material at the level EU/Non-EU could have determined an increase estimated between 10% and 20% in 2017, while in 2019, with a sharp increase of prices due to high demand from China, prices could have been doubled in the EU with the introduction of a similar provision.

Similarly, the introduction of mandatory origin labelling at MS level could imply different burdens in case one country would be affected by ASF. In such a circumstance the burden of a provision requiring the indication of the country of origin, coupled with pressure from retailers and market could imply a very different range of consequences for processors.

When it comes to the real burdens in the hand of processors, it is therefore necessary to take into account the mechanism of prices adaptions from retailers. We saw in the last years that in many cases retailers did not answer in a swift way when processors and farmers were confronted with increases of prices of inputs. And, at the same time, costs derived by labelling, expiration of stocks, etc. were almost totally left on the shoulders of processors.

These are only some concrete examples to let you understand how different policy options can play a different role according to specific circumstances.

Till now our sector found very comfortable to benefit from flexible options as the one provided for by IR EU 775/2018, which can grant a certain flexibility and help to differentiate the added value of products covered by GIs.

We thank you for your attention and we are ready to provide additional concrete examples or to have an interview with the contractor if possible, so that we can better explained in detail the complexity of the issue.

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
