We refer to your e-mail dated 15 July 2022 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 16 July 2022 under the abovementioned reference number.

Your request concerns:

- *“all correspondence, including attachments (i.e. any emails, mail correspondence or telephone call notes) between the Secretariat General, including President Von der Leyen and her cabinet and/or officials, and the company Cheniere;*
- *a list of all meetings and/or calls attended by the Secretary General, including President Von der Leyen, any Cabinet Members and/or official, that were attended by Cheniere as well”.*

The Secretariat-General does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application. As your request does not include a time span for the requested documents, this reply covers the period starting on 1 January 2019.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by the Secretariat-General, the Commission is not in a position to fulfil your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
