I wanted to follow-up on our meeting yesterday to thank both you and Pers for taking the time to meet with Per Person and I.

Per and Person found the conversation insightful and look forward to working with DG Agri and your Commission colleagues on the implementing details of the Fit for 55 package.

Per and Person have asked me to pass on the attached slides from the meeting, as well as a paper which the SBP has drafted on Better Regulation and Certification. I hope this may be of interest and use to you in the context of our conversation yesterday on certification standards. One point of clarity which we would welcome following the meeting, however, is what the scope of the certification standards review will be. Specifically, we are wondering whether this will apply only to biomass/biofuel certification, or whether this will also apply to the RCF and RFNBO sectors. I know that the RED III Directive provides for an expansion of certification for the latter, but wonder whether the review we discussed will also look at issues like transparency and independence in the certification schemes for said non-biological fuels.

We look forward to speaking again over the coming months and would appreciate any clarification you might be able to provide.
