notification of aid under the Guidelines on regional state aid for 2014-2020 ("the RAG") would not take place. Instead, it was proposed to give your authorities the opportunity to provide written comments on these drafts.

In view of the foregoing, please find enclosed the draft supplementary information sheets<sup>2</sup>. Your authorities are requested to submit their written remarks on these forms, if they so wish, by 21 March 2014 to [comp-rag-revision@ec.europa.eu](mailto:comp-rag-revision@ec.europa.eu).

Based on the replies received from your authorities the services of DG Competition will finalise the draft supplementary information sheets and publish them on the DG Competition website. Your authorities are encouraged to use these new forms for notification of regional aid measures that will come into force after 1 July 2014. This will allow the services of DG Competition to check whether any modifications to the proposed information sheets are necessary before their formal adoption in the context of the review of the Implementing Regulation. It goes without saying that Member States will be consulted in due time on the Commission's proposal to modify the Implementing Regulation.
