We refer to your requests for access to European Commission documents registered on 14 July 2023 and 19 July 2023 respectively under the above-mentioned reference numbers.

You request access to *all the documentation (including but not limited to reports, email correspondence, attendance lists, agendas, background papers, transcripts, recordings, and minutes/notes) relating to the lobbying performed in 2022 towards the DG Environment by Alinea Avocats Associés on behalf of its clients Association interprofessionnelle française du bétail et des viandes, Association interprofessionnelle des Fruits et Légumes Frais, and Comité de Liaison des Interprofessions Agricoles et Agro-Alimentaires.*

You also request access to *all the documentation (including but not limited to reports, email correspondence, attendance lists, agendas, background papers, transcripts, recordings, and minutes/notes) relating to exchanges between DG ENV and lobbying firm Aliénor on behalf of its client Interprofession Nationale Porcine (INAPORC).*

We regret to inform you that the Directorate-General for Environment does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your applications.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by the Commission, the Commission is not in a position to fulfil your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
