



## Serious Incident Report

<b>Subject</b>	More than 5 000 Irregular Migrants detected aboard of more than 10 vessels

### 1. Fact of the case

More than 10 boats with migrants were detected by Mare Nostrum. In most cases emergency calls were received. All detections took place South of Lampedusa, close to the Libyan shore.

Following information on the ongoing Incidents is available so far:

- Total number of migrants rescued so far is 3571
- Seven boats with approximately 1600 migrants on board still in queue in order to be rescued;
- Migrants were rescued within the operation Mare Nostrum by Navy vessels as well by Italian Coast Guard vessels
