Dear Madam,

We refer to your e-mail dated 02/11/2016 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 03/11/2016 under the above mentioned reference number, as well as to our previous reply under reference number Ares(2016)6578446 of 23/11/2016.

In your email dated 02/11/2016 you have been '*requesting all invitations, attendance lists, agendas, reading materials, minutes and/ or follow up reports regarding the 27 October 2015 summit on data economy held in Paris; and any follow up events held subsequently.*'

We understand that your request concerned the 'Conférence numérique franco-allemande' held on 27 October 2015 in Paris, hosted by the President of the French Republic. Given that this event was not organised by the European Commission, we were able to identify only documents related to the participation of the representatives of the Commission at the event: an invitation, a detailed agenda and a brief report from the event. We enclose the copy of these documents. Finally, we did not identify any relevant follow up events, and accordingly no documents of the type your above application refers to.
