Both clarifications are in accordance with points laid-out in the tender specifications (pages 12 and 13, respectively). The tenderer replied on October 29th (Ares(2013)3369000) to the effect that is the project manager. Based on the elements on the offer as well as the supplementary elements received by email on October 29th, it is clear that has had no experience in managing projects of a similar size until 2009. The submitted list of projects for which was the manager starts only in April 2012. It is not clear when in 2010 became a Partner at Lexidale, but even if that was in January 2010, and even if experience in managing projects of a similar size had started when became a Partner at Lexidale, that would still mean that would only have just under 4 years' experience managing projects of a similar size. As such, the information submitted regarding the Project Manager leads to the conclusion that the proposed individual does not have at least 5 years' experience in project management, including overseeing project delivery, quality control of delivered service, client orientation and conflict resolution experience in a project of a similar size (as specified in page 12 of the tender specifications).
