2.6. Meeting with Vice President of Indonesia, Mr J. Kalla

A bilateral meeting with Vice President Jusuf Kalla took place in the occasion of the Europe Indonesia Business Dialogue (EIBD), a flagship event co-organised by the European and Indonesian Chambers of Commerce.

The Commissioner briefly presented bilateral trade figures. [Out of scope]
Indonesian exports of palm oil to the EU, EU being the number two export destination after India. The Commissioner mentioned the need for more sustainable palm oil as it is demanded by EU consumers.
