

This is then part of a DPSIR diagram (D=drivers is not part of the topic) so PSIR and then related to the work of ETC-ULS



With respect to soil, the idea would then be to have follow up work on (i) carbon, nutrient and contaminants (1.8.2.1) and soil degradation (1.8.2.2) in the linkage Land management----> soil threats ----> soil functions with focus on

- Crop production (food security)
- Food quality and groundwater quality (human health): links to filter/buffer function
- Biodiversity protection
