The European Defence Fund is a major new policy initiative by the European Commission for the next Multi-annual Financial Framework. It shall promote competitiveness of the European Defence and Technological Industrial Base by incentivising and funding collaborative research and development projects. The total budget is foreseen to be 1.5 Billion Euros per year for the seven year period 2021 – 2027.

The European Commission will put forward a legal proposal for the European Defence Fund in May / June 2018. To accompany this legal proposal the European Commission will publish an impact assessment. As such the study shall assess the problem setting, policy options and impacts of the EDF.
