As per information provided by WFP, the first batch of milk have been dispatched to Tartous and Latakia WFP warehouse (see photos sent by Jakob Kern, head of WFP Damascus) on 14-15.11.2016.

The first batch arrived in two shipments in late October and successfully underwent lab testing. The total tonnage of 1,497 mt of milk have then been transferred to WFP warehouses.

Once in WFP warehouses, Partner will commence the regular dispatches to schools as per distribution plan below. The initial targeted areas will be Lattakia, Tartous and Homs in order to absorb the quantities that have an earlier expiry date (24 January) to be followed by schools in other governorates.

The school authorities in the respective governorates have been informed.

WFP will keep ECHO informed about the actual dispatch and distribution.
