Thank you for your request for access to documents, dated 14 August 2018, which the EEAS has examined in the framework of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001¹.

You requested access to "all correspondence, including emails, agendas, records of meetings, minutes of meetings, participants lists and any other reports of such meetings involving officials/representatives/Commissioner/cabinet member of the EEAS with the following two entities:

SAPER VEDERE, Rue de la Cible 50, 1030 Brussels, +32 471 77 94 52; EU DisinfoLab; Rue de la Cible 50, 1030 Brussels, +32 471 77 94 52"

and "all contracts concluded with the above-mentioned entities and all information regarding payments of the EEAS to any of the two entities."

Following your request, we have searched the EEAS database for i.) correspondence relating to any possible meetings with the two above-mentioned entities and ii.) contracts concluded with the above-mentioned entities. No registered documents were found in our database. I can also confirm that no contracts have been concluded and no related payments were done involving the EEAS with the two entities.

However, we identified two unregistered e-mails that would fall into the scope of your request:

- 1. E-mail correspondence concerning the "Brussels Disinfo Lab on 14 September 2017"
- 2. E-mail correspondence concerning the "Spring School Resilience League 2018"

I wish to inform you that we are (in accordance with Article 4.4 of Regulation 1049/2001) obliged to consult the third party concerned, i.e. the author of the correspondence on the possibility of public disclosure.
