With reference to the Informal Summary Record of 4 October 2017 and the discussion during the Working Group Novel Food on 2 October 2017 concerning hemp (*Cannabis sativa*) products, I would like to inform that food supplements, which were notified the Chief Sanitary Inspector, contain hemp flowers extracts produced using the technique of the supercritical CO2 extraction.

According to the information provided by food business operators (FBO), these food supplements contain naturally occurring CBD in the range from 0,5 mg to nearly 390 mg CBD in the recommended daily portion. Furthermore in some cases the mentioned above food supplements contain naturally occurring CBDa.

Simultaneously, I would like to indicate that recently the Chief Sanitary Inspector was notified about the introduction of food supplements containing additionally, inter alia, hemp seed extracts, produced using the technique of the supercritical CO2 extraction.

Because of the ongoing administrative procedure conducted by the State Sanitary Inspection on food supplements, which contain these mentioned ingredients, your information will be very helpful in that issues. Due to the urgency of that matter I am looking forward to the outcome of the discussion during the Working Group Novel Food on 6 December 2017.
