The specific issue of endocrine disruptors has not been discussed so far between the Chief Scientific Adviser and the President of the European Commission, his representatives or any other persons and organisations mentioned in your request.


The Chief Scientific Adviser has spoken at events organised by the European Policy Centre and the European Risk Forum, but these events were targeted at a broader risk context. The Chief Scientific Adviser has not talked about endocrine disruptors at these events and the Commission does not hold any documents related to these events mentioning the matter.

The Chief Scientific Adviser has participated in an event organised by MEP Julie Girling on 22/01/2013 entitled "Risk versus Hazard, with reference to the Westlund Report on Endocrine Disruptors". The Chief Scientific Adviser's intervention and contributions did not discuss, however, the issue of endocrine disruptors. The Commission does not have any minutes or recordings of this event.
