We refer to your e-mail of 08/04/2019 registered on 09/04/2019 under the above mentioned reference number, by which you made a request pursuant to Regulation No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents¹.

"A complete of list of all meetings held by any member of your team/staff with churches, religious associations or communities, as well as with philosophical and nonconfessional organisations, from 1 January 2014 onwards, specifying the status of the organization (church, religious association or community, philosophical association or non-confessional association). All documents, including all emails, minutes, reports or other documents received or drawn up before, during or after the meetings, and any other briefing papers related to these meetings.
