EU CCC confirmed that <b>they see benefits in negotiating disciplines in CAI</b> ensuring equal treatment in participation in standard-setting bodies for foreign invested companies. While <b>access to technical committees (TCs)</b> was mentioned as a key concern, the challenge is ensuring right to effective participation.  Art. 4.1 (a)
