DG CLIMA and ACEA exchanged views on the latest developments in climate policy, in particular with regards to road transport. ACEA informed about the state of implementation of the upcoming CO2 emission targets and the need for further deployment alternative fuels infrastructures to accompany the uptake of zero and low emission vehicles. ACEA underlined the need to develop an EU approach to stimulate the use of decarbonised hydrogen, in particular for long-distance transport. ACEA was also interested on the political guidelines of the President-Elect with regards to climate policies. DG CLIMA indicated that the implementation of the political guidelines will be accompanied by timely consultation of stakeholders and thorough impact assessment, as announced by the President.
