Thank you for your e-mail of 25.09.2020, which was registered on the same day, requesting access to documents under Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L145, 31 May 2001, page 43 and following).

Your e-mail requested access to documents as follows:
