I hope this message finds you well. I am contacting you on behalf of Huawei.

First of all, I wish you a wonderful 2020.

One of the stated objectives of the European Commission is to pursue digital revolution and ensure Europe's digital sovereignty and security. Huawei's activities in Europe are fully aligned with these aims. We are committed to contributing to the performance and growth of Europe's digital industry by providing the best products and services to companies and individuals, and by building mutually beneficial partnerships built on excellence.

As you might know, Huawei plans to build new factory capacities in Europe to make 5G equipment. The motto is the following: "5G for Europe made in Europe". Huawei is conducting a feasibility study to open factories in Europe for this purpose. The choice of the countries will depend on that study.

Moreover, in the area of Artificial Intelligence (AI), Huawei is committed to investing in the AI computing industry in Europe, enabling enterprises and individual developers to leverage the Ascend AI series products for technological and business innovation. Over the next 5 years, Huawei plans to invest 100 million euros in the AI Ecosystem Program in Europe, helping industry organizations, 200,000 developers, 500 ISV partners, and 50 universities and research institutes to boost innovation.

With regards to the legitimate concerns and safeguards needed in relation to the deployment of 5G, Huawei is and always has been willing and able to provide all the necessary guarantees needed for a trusting relationship with the European authorities to be founded.
