Dear Mr Grizzuti,

Re: Your application for access to documents – Ref 20-3292

We refer to your email dated 3 August 2020 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on the same day under the above-mentioned reference number.

Your application is currently being handled. However, we will not be in a position to complete the handling of your application within the time limit of 15 working days, which expires on 24 August 2020.

An extended time limit is needed as your application concerns a large number of documents. Moreover, there are documents generated by third parties that ECDC should have to consult about before deciding on disclosure.

Therefore, we have to extend the time limit with 15 working days in accordance with Article 7(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents. Therefore, the new time limit expires on 14 September 2020.
