We refer to your e-mail of 17 November 2020, registered on the same date under the above-mentioned reference number.

1. Scope of your request

On the basis of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001², you made the following request:

'Details of grants provided by the European Commission for the facilitation of GDPR Codes of Conduct, referred to in this parliamentary answer: https://www.europarl.europa.eu/doceo/document/P-9-2020-004834-ASW_EN.html - The cost of any such grants and which parties will receive the funds.'

2. No documents held

We regret to inform you that the Directorate-General for Health and Food safety does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

You may receive a separate response from other Commission departments in case they are able to identify any documents falling within the scope of your request.

The Commission announced on 19 February in the European Strategy on Data that it would "facilitate the establishment, in accordance with Article 40 of the GDPR, of a Code of Conduct for processing of personal data in health sector. These actions will build upon an ongoing mapping of the use of personal health data in Member States and the results of the Joint Action in the context of the Health programme (2020-2023)." In its Communication on two years of application of the General Data Protection Regulation, the Commission reiterated its support to "encourage, including through financial support, the drafting of EU codes of conduct in the area of health and research". As explained in the reply to the Parliamentary Question referred to in the request, the Commission will support financially the development of Codes of Conduct in the area of health through grants, with actions to be started as of 2021. No such actions have started yet in the area of health.

As specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the Institution.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by the Commission Directorate-General for Health and Food safety, we are not in a position to fulfil your request.

3. Means of redress

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.

Such a confirmatory application should be addressed within 15 working days upon receipt of this letter to the Secretariat-General of the Commission at the following address:
