Dear Ms Chapuis,

On behalf of VCI, I would like to thank you again for your presentation and the good and open discussion we had at our Political Committee meeting on Thursday.

As an industry we are committed to achieving the 2050 GHG-neutrality target. To reach this goal as a sector we will need, according to a <u>landmark VCI study</u>, 11 times more energy in form of renewable electricity at a competitive price. The massive increase in demand for electricity is closely linked to a substantial increase in demand for hydrogen – the German chemical industry is projected to use 7 mio tons per year in 2050, from currently 1 mio ton.

This shows that massive investments and accelerated infrastructure approval procedures are required. In our understanding, an additional political and societal push is urgently needed if we want to succeed. The current policy projections might fall short of the real market needs of the future.

We would be glad to explain these considerations more in detail and receiving your assessment. Could you please let us know when such an online meeting could take place?
