We refer to your request for access to documents, registered on 24/03/2021 under the above-mentioned reference number.

You request access to a list of all meetings where Coca-Cola, any trade organisation which they are a member of, or a third party organisation which represents them, were held since 1 January 2018. Please see enclosed the documents my services have identified.

Please note that a complete disclosure of the identified replies is prevented by the exception concerning the protection of privacy and the integrity of the individual outlined in Article 4(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, to the extent they contain personal data, in particular the full name of the submitters and the email addresses provided. Those have been blackened in the enclosed document.

Consequently, pursuant to Article 4(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, access cannot be granted to the personal data contained in the requested replies, as the need to obtain access thereto for a purpose in the public interest has not been substantiated and there is no reason to think that the legitimate interests of the individuals concerned would not be prejudiced by disclosure of the personal data concerned.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position with regard to the refusal of disclosing personal data.
