Dear Dr Clausing,

I refer to your application for access to documents submitted on 9 May 2021 by means of which you asked for:

- the information "how many combined exposure assessments of pesticides based on the EFSA Guidance on risk assessment of combined exposure to multiple chemicals (cf. EFSA Journal 2019;17(3)5634) have actually been performed?" and
- "documents containing these assessments or provide a link where I can download these".

Please rest assured that your application is being processed as quickly as possible in accordance with the provisions of <u>Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001</u> on public access to documents (hereinafter "the PAD Regulation").

We proposed to handle your PAD application in successive stages allowing for a detailed assessment on the accessibility of each of the documents falling within the scope of your application and we targeted as next deadline to reply to you 16 July 2021.

However, in view of the large number of documents EFSA is processing under the PAD Regulation and the holidays period implying a reduction of staff, with a view to reconciling your interests with those of good administration, we would like to engage with you as concerns the processing of your PAD application. In this respect, in accordance with Article 6(3) of the PAD Regulation, as implemented by Articles 4(7) and 4(8) of Decision of the Management Board laying down practical arrangements for implementing Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 and Articles 6 and 7 of Regulation (EC) No 1367/2006, we would like to confer with you with a view to finding a fair solution to provide you with a reply on the accessibility of a second and final batch of the requested documents by **16 August 2021 at the latest**.
