Please note that due to the wide scope of your request, covering also areas falling under the responsibility of other Directorates-General, parts of your request have been attributed to other Directorates-Generals. This reply relates only to the documents held by the Directorate-General for Internal Market, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs. You received /will receive the replies from the other respective Directorates-General in due course.

We regret to inform you that the DG GROW does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.
