As a follow up to those discussions please let me know if you would like me to set up a meeting with the [Auto Alliance](#) (representing all US based manufacturers) and the [Auto Policy Council](#) (AAPC -- representing just the Detroit 3 but very trade

focused and quite influential on US trade po icy) while the Commissioner is in DC next month.
