Subject: Meeting on CBAM and the conditions for the fertilizer sector

Dear Mr. Vandenberghe,

As you are well aware, fertilizers are among the few sectors selected to be part of the first phase of the CBAM.

The present Commission thinking as represented in the most recent leak makes us very nervous about being in the first wave of sectors. It seems as if the Commission does not have the courage to present a CBAM proposal that could work, and the consequences of half-hearted measures could be very damaging to the sectors included.

We have been writing to EVP Timmermans, see attachment, explaining the conditions necessary for the fertilizer sector to see any perspective in joining the CBAM.

We are planning soon also to send a letter to Commission President and the College of Commissioners, but before doing so I would appreciate we could arrange a meeting where I could go more in the detail of our concerns with you.
