# Communication/information

**Thematic seminars**: DG Research is organising a seminar on each of its thematic priorities, aimed at presenting the new instruments to information multipliers. CREST and Research Group are being informed.

A letter has been addressed by A.Mitsos to R.Verrue concerning the seminars and also the issue of "calls for expression of interest".

#### Interaction with other institutions

- **Council Research Group**: The note being drafted for the Research Group concerning joint and several liability will be circulated to the TF members by **A3**.
- European Parliament: next meeting of ITRE on 25th February.

### • Evaluation criteria

The subgroup (LvdB, MM, Isabel Minguez and CR) had a further meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> February, dedicated to the criteria regarding NoE, adding a third "pillar" (management) to excellence and integration. Criteria for stairways of excellence finalised within the Working group; global approach: global questions, representing as an average 1 ½ page per instrument, split in more detailed items (that would be included either in an annex or in the work programme). PK strongly against quantitative measure in the criteria while in favour of requesting the related information in the calls for proposals. Next meeting of the subgroup planned on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> February, with a view to finalising the document on NoE criteria for discussion during a next TF meeting.

## Model contract

One model contract with general conditions, and 9 different set of conditions, without any derived contract; submission of the **model contract** to the **Steering group** on 12<sup>th</sup> **February**, as to be ready to sent the document by 26<sup>th</sup> February at the latest for the next meeting with the Member States planned on 12<sup>th</sup> March.

## Role of SMEs in the new instruments

Short presentation of the issue by RJS, discussion of the exact meaning of the "15% of the resources dedicated to the priory themes to be spent for SMEs". Further **document** to be jointly prepared by **RJS** and INFSO representatives (**MM**, **KR**) as to be discussed **within two weeks** by the TF. (SMEs in instruments, stairways of excellence, possible addition of evaluation criteria related to SME involvement...)

# • Financial regime for Networks of excellence

Agreement was reached on the following points:

- Number of researchers to be taken into account defined at the time of the deadline for the call for proposals
- Taken into account of all researchers planned at that time
- Taken into account of all researchers engaged in the JPA, including partially (formula to be clarified)
- Necessity of defining a clear common position before meeting with DG BUDG on the issue

**PK** will review his text for next week, **next meeting** to be exclusively **dedicated** to the **financial aspects of NoE and IP**, with participation of "financial people" of both RTD and INFGSO. In the meantime, **JDM** to arrange a subgroup to be chaired by **PK** with Lehner and financial representatives from DG INFSO, anyone interested being welcome.
