Subject: Your application for access to documents – GESTDEM 2022/1751

Dear Sir,

We refer to your application dated 22 March 2022 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 25 March 2022 under the abovementioned reference number.

You request access to documents which contain the following information:

"Any information that was provided by DG Move to any EU member states concerning sanctions against Russian Air Carriers and Russian registered aircrafts and the implementation of these measures.".

Having examined your request under the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup> (hereinafter 'Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001'), we have come to the conclusion that two documents containing information provided to Member States concerning the sanctions

Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents (OJ L 145, 31.5.2001, p. 43).

Pursuant to Art 4(6) of Regulation (EC) 1049/2001, we have considered whether partial access could be granted to these documents. However, given their nature and structure, partial access would have similar effects as the complete access to the documents. It follows from the assessment made above that the requested documents are entirely covered by the aforementioned exceptions.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.

Such a confirmatory application should be addressed within 15 working days upon receipt of this letter to the Secretary-General of the Commission at the following address:
