With many thanks to [REDACTED] for conducting it, we had a very good meeting with Twitter on the developments in the Code. If I may summarise the main points:

- Code of conduct referred to as “Best in the class” vis a vis all voluntary tools initiated by the Commission (on disinfo, Eu internet forum etc)
- No urgency to have a Code 2.0, best to wait for DSA and in the meantime prioritise strengthened engagement with civil society trusted flaggers
- Strong support to revamping the “Dublin” workshops. We spoke concretely of a session in early March. Focus on exchange btw NGOs and content moderation teams on: a) how to improve notification processes, b) trends on content from the ground and c) possibly on how to “train” machine learning (this one more delicate)
- Support to the monitoring methodology, will provide concrete technical suggestions that can help their review of the cases at the end of each monitoring.
