Dear Digital Armenia,

You recently submitted a complaint to the European Ombudsman against the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) concerning how it dealt with your request for public access to documents related to a crowdfunding exercise.

I am sorry to have to tell you that the Ombudsman is unable to deal with your complaint. This is because the Ombudsman may investigate complaints from EU citizens or natural or legal persons residing or having their registered office in an EU Member State. From the information provided in your complaint, it appears that you do not meet these criteria.<sup>1</sup>
