**Subject: Your application for access to documents – Ref GestDem No 2014/1515**

We refer to your e-mail dated 17 March 2014 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 19 March under the above mentioned reference number.

Your last request is linked to the reply I provided you as regards request 2014/418 in which I indicated that for many of your requests, we did not find documents concerning Lumos.

You now request documents involving Lumos as a Secretariat of the European Expert Group on Transition from Institutional to Community based care.

On the basis of your request 2014/418 which was very large and of my reply of 5 March 2014, the description given in your latest application can lead to various understandings and is not precise enough to enable DG EMPL services to undertake a proper and efficient research, bearing in mind that such a research does not fall under their core activity.

I therefore invite you, pursuant to Article 6(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to documents, to provide me with more detailed information on the documents which you seek to obtain, such as:

- the framework in which they were drafted,
- dates or periods during which the documents would have been produced,
- persons or bodies who drafted the documents.


