Dear all,

It is my pleasure to share with you in attachment Nestlé's individual contribution to component 2 of the EU Code of Conduct, as well as our logo.

The document includes an introductory section that provides the rationale for the structure and selection of the individual commitments and reporting frameworks outlined in detail in the table. In this respect, we have also included an Annex with a description of Nestlé's material issues and materiality analysis, as well as a list of standards and frameworks that Nestlé discloses to.

In the table, we have also included a comments column to provide relevant context per individual commitment, where needed, as well as a column to indicate how each individual commitment relates to one of the EU Code of Conduct's aspirational objectives and targets (included for reference also in the Annex).

As mentioned in the introductory section of the attachment, I would like to highlight that Nestlé is in the process of launching its post-2020 public commitments. The individual commitments outlined in the table reflect the core of these renewed post-2020 public commitments. On top of these renewed commitments, no additional ones have been taken explicitly for the purpose of the EU Code of Conduct.

Some of our renewed commitments (notably those linked to nutrition, in view of our new strategy to be launched in early 2022) still need to be further refined. These have been marked as such in their "comments" column. Where possible and relevant, commitments specific to Nestlé's activities in Europe have been included.

Our commitments will be adapted based on our progress and/or shifting priorities in line with future materiality analyses, with a view to remain aligned with the high ambition set by the EU Code of Conduct.

We remain strongly convinced of the added value and opportunities that come with the EU Code of Conduct to foster more coordinated and collective action to transition towards sustainable food systems in Europe (and beyond). As Nestlé we will continue to show this support moving forward.
