Dear [REDACTED],

I hope this message finds you well.

I am writing on behalf of Stora Enso. We are a renewable materials company that employs 18 000 people in the EU, with decades of experience in sustainable forest management (SFM) as well as in the manufacturing of renewable, circular and sustainable packaging.

Stora Enso fully supports the Green Deal objectives of protecting biodiversity and achieving climate neutrality. Our products substitute fossil-based alternatives and save approximately 18 million tonnes of CO2 entering the atmosphere (2019).

Having said that, I firmly believe there is always room for improvement. All companies, and other relevant actors, must continue to evolve, including our industry. Businesses across the world need to step up to the challenge of operating within planetary boundaries. It is the right thing to do – but it also represents the best opportunity to ensure the relevance of business in the future. The task for us as companies is to use this quest as the lens for product innovation and business model transformation. It is in that spirit I am reaching out to you to ask for a meeting with our [REDACTED] and CEO [REDACTED] [REDACTED] on how we can best ensure ways forward that will mitigate climate change through responsible and sustainable business operations and product innovations.

Woody biomass has a role to play in the European bioeconomy. At Stora Enso, we believe that wood must be used to manufacture renewable and circular products that will increasingly replace fossil-based ones, thus decarbonising value chains. We are keen to navigate our way through this complex landscape to find the right balance. Ms. Bresky would therefore welcome the opportunity to meet you and explore how we can find this balance in the ongoing forestry policy dossiers such as the deforestation and nature restoration proposal as well as in more upcoming policies such as for example monitoring and observation.

Furthermore, she would also like to take the opportunity to discuss the upcoming proposals for the revision of the Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive. It would be good to have a conversation on how we can ensure that our renewable material is kept in the loop for longer through reuse and recycling to ensure we store as much carbon as possible and follow cascading use principles.

We would be grateful if such a meeting would be possible on 7 October (or on 10 November, when [REDACTED] will be in Brussels again).

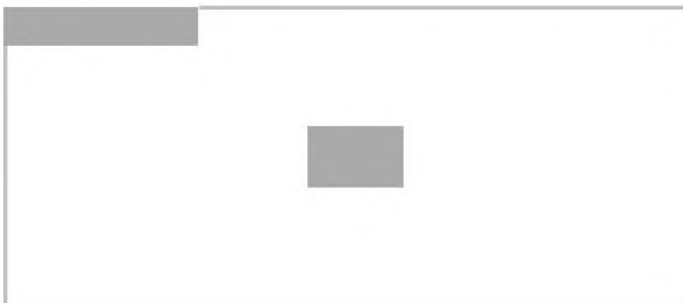
