Issues raised & follow-up	<p>The visitors presented briefly their report on the European Green Deal, then had an exchange with the Commission on its state of play. They raised the following topics: electricity market design review; decarbonisation of industry and circular economy; the role of digitisation in the green transition.</p> <p>The Commission representative provided an update on the state of play of implementation of the Green Deal, in particular progress in the discussions between co-legislators on the Fit for 55 package, new legislative proposals by the Commission (e.g. in the circular economy field) and the measures taken to address the energy crisis.</p>
