Dear all,

As a follow-up to the high-level convening "*Campaigns helping consumers to save on their energy bills*" of 17 October 2022 under the EU-U.S. Energy Security Task Force and as per the message from Ms Juul Jørgensen on Monday, **we would like to invite you to a technical discussion to elaborate on possible next steps for transatlantic cooperation to save energy. This meeting will take place online on 3rd November, between 14:30-16:00, please see connection details at the bottom of this message.**

We propose to focus the meeting on three main questions:

1. What are the main lessons/ experience/ best practices related to consumer campaigns and offers on demand reduction and demand flexibility and where concretely could EU learn from U.S. and vice versa?
2. How could the EU-U.S. Task Force facilitate exchanges between the relevant EU and U.S. associations on innovative flexible electricity offers and energy efficiency measures allowing consumers to save in the ongoing crisis?
3. How to better articulate the EU commercial interest in demand side flexibility, energy efficiency and clean energy technologies in the transatlantic cooperation?
