I would like to thank you for your request for access to documents, which the EEAS has examined in the framework of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001.<sup>1</sup>

Following your request, we have searched for: “*documents which contain the following information: the EEAS conflict analysis for Kosovo*”, in the EEAS filing systems and document management databases.

I regret to inform you that no documents matching your request have been identified.

As specified in Article 2(3) of the Regulation, the right of access as defined in that Regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.
