Subject: Your application for access to documents – Ref GestDem No 2015/2503

We refer to your email dated 29/04/2015 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on the same day under the above mentioned reference number.

We regret to inform you that no documents were found that would correspond to the description given in your application. In fact there was only a short exchange on 24 April 2015 between Mrs Åsenius from the Cabinet of the Trade Commissioner Cecilia Malmström and a representative of the American Chamber of Commerce on the logistics of the next meeting, which in the meantime has been cancelled.

Indeed, as specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents have been identified, the Commission is not in a position to handle your request. In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
