Dear Ms Cann,

I refer to your e-mail dated 17 August 2015 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 18 August 2015 under the above-mentioned reference number.

Your application concerns *"all documents relating to notifications from Mr Frydman regarding individual clients "whose activities are related to those which he had in the Commission in his last 3 years of service", and any authorisations/ rejections/ restrictions made by the Commission in response"*.

I regret to inform you that no documents were found that would correspond to the description given in your application.

Indeed, as specified in Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that Regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.
