Your application for access to documents pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents – ref. GestDem 2016/78

Dear Mr Panichi,

I refer to your e-mail of 6 January 2016, registered on 7 January 2016, by which you make a request pursuant to Regulation No 1049/2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents<sup>1</sup>.

You request access to all correspondence written by Martin Selmayr, the chef de cabinet of Commission President Jean-Claude Juncker, about Italian Prime Minister Matteo Renzi, between November and December 2015. By email dated 7 January 2016 you further specified that you request access to correspondence from Mr Selmayr to other members of the Juncker cabinet which name explicitly Italian Prime Minister Matteo Renzi in the time period I have specified.

We regret to inform you that no documents were found that would correspond to the description given in your application.

Indeed, as specified in Article 2 (3) of Regulation 1049/2001, the right of access as defined in that regulation applies only to existing documents in the possession of the institution.

Given that no such documents have been identified, the Commission is not in a position to handle your request.

In case you would disagree with the above assessment, you are entitled, in accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation 1049/2001, to introduce a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
