We refer to your e-mail dated 26/04/2016 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 29/04/2016 under the above mentioned reference number. An initial reply was sent to you on 03/05/2016 explaining that an extended time limit (until 20/06/2016) is needed as your application concerns an old infringement involving a search in our historical archives (which are located in a different building) and potentially concerns a large number of documents.
