



Brussels, Warsaw, 20 July 2011

Excellency,

It is with pleasure that we invite you to the second Eastern Partnership Summit, which shall take place in Warsaw on 29-30 September 2011.

The Warsaw Summit will be the opportunity to demonstrate our commitment to the Eastern Partnership and its goals which were set by the Prague Summit in 2009, as well as evaluate our efforts to implement the Partnership effectively. The Warsaw Summit will also allow us to debate the future of the Eastern Partnership as an ambitious policy of the European Union and its East European Partners as well as suggest further developments and joint initiatives on both the bilateral and multilateral dimensions.

The Summit will start with a working dinner dedicated to a strategic discussion amongst leaders. The plenary session on the following day will allow broader discussions with stakeholders and the adoption of a joint declaration. We, together with the President of the European Commission and the former Hungarian presidency of the Council, share high ambitions and strong expectations for this meeting.

Two important events will take place in the margins of the Summit and will contribute to our debates. An Eastern Partnership conference on civil society will be held in Warsaw, and the Eastern Partnership Business Forum will meet for the first time in Sopot.

The EURONEST Parliamentary Assembly second session and the first meeting of the Conference of Regional and Local Authorities will meet before the Summit and the results of their deliberations will possibly be shared at the Summit.

We intend to fine-tune the content of our debates as we move closer to the Summit. At the beginning of September we will provide you with more detailed information on the substance.

We look forward to your attendance and active contribution to the Summit.
